1. Fold-away Floor Scrubbers

The battery operated version is ideal for small areas like for instance washrooms with hard to reach areas that will be difficult to clean with a trailing power lead. The battery could be charged and used for more or less 4 hours previous to re-charging is required. The battery could also be changed if necessary.

3. Ride-on or Walking devices

Another great choice for a floor scrubber if the area you need it for is big like warehouses and different industrial sites are the walking or ride-on scrubber equipment. These models will allow the worker to steer the machines all-around corners and obstructions easily and efficiently.
