Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop initially hiring four people. Sales for their initial year of operation amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Through 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is among the top global manufacturers in the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively engage in better business opportunities. All through the final sixty years, the industry of material handling has developed into a really advanced field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the best supplier of forklift attachments and various related products. The company feels confident in their ability so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the world market.

Through the 1950's, Cascade started to make, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A new facility was constructed in the year 1956, to be able to house all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's current headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total staff reached 180 staff and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

The next manufacturing plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry when the company recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In the year 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Since then the business has expanded its manufacturing amenities within the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are fabricated worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This plant is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and the year 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five firms, along with the global leader in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
